

## Corner Cabinet

**Turn the #77366 Corner Cabinet into a stylish, shabby-chic storage for sweaters.**

1. Remove the plastic glazing and the knobs.
2. Sand the cabinet to remove the surface shine.
3. Clean away the dust and prime with Gesso (#55309); two coats may be needed for complete coverage but just one is a good base for the shabby look.
4. Paint as desired.
5. Replace the glazing and add new knobs or pulls, #15545 used here.



The sweaters are images gathered from various online sources and manipulated in Photoshop to fit the shelf space, then printed, cut out and attached to small pieces of foam core to sit on the shelves. You could create a similar but three-dimensional look with scraps of fabric folded or wrapped over foam core pieces and glued into stacks. Another idea that would need fewer sweaters is to cut cardboard to replace the glazing in the lower half of the doors and paint it to match the cabinet.
