Crafty Extras:

- The round object on the bottom shelf is a marble, resting in a ring of paper.
- To prepare for finishing, door and drawer knobs were carefully removed and the acrylic glazing was removed from doors. After a light sanding, a stained layer with red permanent marker. Next, a coat of black acrylic ink. Beadboard (#9667) sections were glued to the inside before a final light sanding and a coat of high quality black acrylic paint. Next, very fine grit sanding in a few areas to reveal the red undercolor. The inside of the cabinet has two coats of clear satin varnish; the outside has two coats of transparent créme wax, buffed to a soft gloss.
- The door knobs are #12007 Wooden Knobs, painted bronze with nail polish. The drawer pulls are #71504 Antique Brass Drawer Pulls. Their finish was a close match to the painted knobs, but they were painted as well for a better match. (The acrylic glazing was not in place for the photo.)
