Crafty Extras:

- The dresser was modified by taking the mirror mounts off of the molding on top of the dresser and adding two faux drawers with a back between them. The molding is MDF, the mirror mounts are wood, so the molding was destroyed to remove it. The faux drawers are the cut-off ends of two giant craft sticks (this is a designated size, look for them at craft stores and Walmart) with a strip of cardstock glued between for the body of the drawers.
- The floral decorations are rub-on decals that have been in my stash for a very long time, plus highlights in gold paint. The faux drawers have gold crimp beads for knobs. The bottles and jars are beads and jewelry findings from my stash; the picture frame is item #51516, and the paper items are printed images found on the internet. The diary is a small book with a colored cardstock strap glued on and another thickness of cardstock painted gold for the lock.
- The stool cushion has been recovered in a thin, textured fabric. I tied on a blue silk ribbon bow for softness; the vase and flowers (repainted) are from my stash.
