## Simple Craft Stick Bench <br> by Fran Casselman

## Tools needed:

\#55666 Miter Box with Saw Tools
\#41134 Ultimate Easy Cutter
\#1249 Weldbond (White Glue)
\#80873 Grey Age-It EASY or
\#1073 Fred's Wood Weathering Stuff
Two jumbo craft sticks (tongue-depressor size)
One standard craft stick (popsicle-stick size)
Ruler
Pencil
Tweezers (may be helpful)
Other items in the scene were crafted and/or purchased from craft stores and other retailers.

Some miniatures.com items listed may be temporarily unavailable or may be permanently discontinued; we apologize for any inconvenience.

1. Cut the rounded ends off of the jumbo craft sticks and cut one 4 " length (seat) and two $11 / 4$ " lengths (legs). Draw a line $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ in from each end of the 4 " piece.
2. At the $45^{\circ}$ setting, cut two lengths (braces) from the regular craft stick, $11 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on the long side. (They should look like an isosceles trapezoid. Precise length is not critical as long as they are the same.)
3. Stain the pieces now. Stain all sides; the pieces may warp while they are wet but will flatten as they dry, or you can weight them down. (\#80873 dries very quickly)
4. Glue a leg on the pencil line; hold it for a few seconds until the glue catches.
5. Glue the second leg and hold it.
6. Apply glue to both ends of a brace and set it in place, straightening the leg as necessary.
7. Glue the second brace. Enjoy your bench!
