Crafty Extras:

- The chair and bench cushions were made with 1/4" foam, quilting cotton, and tacky glue. For a finished look, 1/2" wide fabric strips are folded, pressed, and tacky glued around each cushion.
- The decorative pillows were made with quilting cotton. Create a template using cardstock. These are 1 3/4" cushions. Trace the template on the wrong side of the quilting cotton. With right sides of the quilting cotton together, stitch on the line with a small stitch length. Start and stop sewing, leaving an opening big enough to turn inside out. Trim your seam allowance to 1/4" and clip the corners close to the stitching. Turn, press, and fill with your choice of material.
