Crafty Extras:

- The mounted butterflies were images found online then sized to scale and printed (two copies of each). She then cut them out and glued one flat in the frame; the other was glued just along the body so she could bend the wings out slightly to create a little dimension.
- Morgen found images she liked online then used simple computer software to resize and print the images. Before framing them, she gave them a bit of texture using Mod Podge.
- Morgen wanted to create an umbrella stand that resembled majolica pottery. She started with the tall terra-cotta pot from #55195 and used gel nail polish to create a base coat. While it was still wet, she swirled in an accent color.
- The wallpaper is #45202, Embossed Ceiling Paper, painted green. Morgen used a dark brown acrylic paint to age it and make the texture stand out. She cut the paper into 11/2" wide strips and used Mod Podge to glue them to the wall.
