

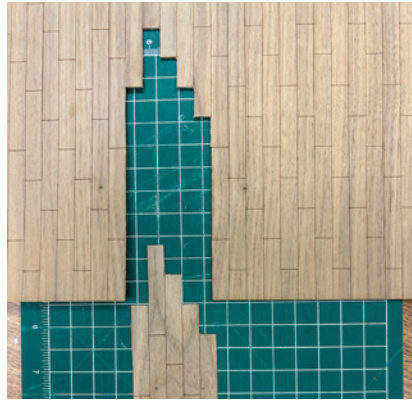
## Wood Flooring Sheets

The wood flooring sheets are made of real wood and therefore might show a life-scale pattern in the grain (see Step 1). If the pattern is not desirable, consider cutting along the laser lines to break up and redistribute the life-scale pattern. The following four steps explain how.



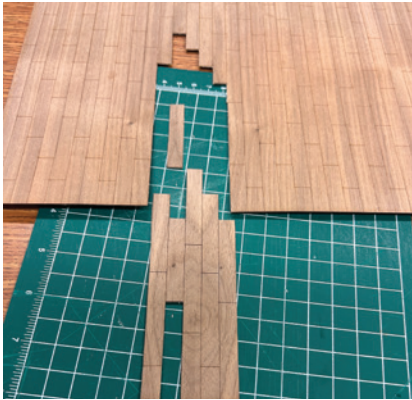
### Step 1.

Observe the grain in the flooring sheet and identify the pattern to be changed.



### Step 2.

Cut out the pattern from the flooring sheet. Use a combination of a sharp blade and scissors to cut along the laser lines.



### Step 3.

Cut out individual pieces along the laser lines to break up the life-scale pattern in the grain. Cut out as many pieces and in locations that are necessary to break up the pattern.



### Step 4.

When ready to install the flooring, first glue down the flooring sheet. Then glue down what remains of the cut-out pattern. Then glue the individual pieces into the empty spaces so that the resulting pattern is pleasing. Add weights so that everything dries flat.
