Photography Tips:

- 1. Do not use the flash on your camera. Instead, use full daylight or electric light sources aimed onto your project from two directions to eliminate most hard shadows. If the hard light is still causing shadows, aim the lights away from the project onto white sheets of foamcore or mat board; the reflected light will be much softer and more diffused. Outdoors, white boards can be used to reflect the sunlight up and onto your project in the same way.
- 2. Clamp-on utility lights with aluminum shades are inexpensive, good light sources, and are readily available at hardware/ home improvement stores. Use at least 1600 lumens bulbs (100 watt equivalent). These portable lights can be clamped and positioned to provide good light for photos.
- 3. Remember, your photos are the only way we have to judge your project. All the time, effort and talent you put into your project will be wasted—in the eyes of the judges—by blurry, out-offocus photos. Also, take care to frame your whole project in the viewfinder without cropping off a corner or the top, and try to avoid having distracting items in the background.
