

Elegant 1920s Bathroom

Setting:

- #88217 Pastel Blue Glass Mosaic Tile
- #88216 Beige Glass Mosaic Tile*
- #74034 Multi-Grip Glue
- #2076 Mortar Mix
- #42053 Swirled Paisley Wallpaper
- #81430 1/8" Quarter Round Molding (*painted bronze, above tiles*)

Furnishings:

- #54015 Updated Basic Bathroom
- #20202 Cane Tub Chair
- #37121 Metro Bedroom Mirror (*painted and embellished with stickers and antiquing glaze*)
- #2828 Kent Wall Sconce

Accessories:

- #22205 Chrysnbn Bathroom Accessories Set (*wastebasket, covered with wallpaper scrap and painted bronze interior; soap dish, with painted soap; toothbrushes and holder; water glass and holder, with details painted bronze*)
- #25163 Turquoise Plush Carpet (*bath mat, ribbon-embellished rug and towels*)
- #78611 Jewel-Tone Bottles (*one on bath tray; tray and other bottles made from jewelry findings and beads*)



Crafting Tips:

Shower rod and towel holders made from 3/32" aluminum tubing and jewelry findings. Shower curtain is a fabric swatch with decorative binding for header and tie back; hung from jump rings.

*The border of small tiles is made using the beige glass mosaic tiles, but the translucent glass is similar in tone to the mortar and did not stand out well, so the individual "tiles" were enhanced with cream paint and the entire row glazed with dark brown antiquing stain. A line of stiffened embroidery thread was used as an accent above and below the tiles.
